



2025-2026 Dress Code

Tops

Tops must fully cover the chest, abdomen, and midriff. Permissible options include shirts, blouses, sweaters, and jackets. T-shirts and Hoodies can have graphics, but they should be appropriate. Tops should maintain coverage even when arms are raised. Avoid any wording or graphics related to sex, vulgarity, drugs, gangs, weapons, or alcohol. Opt for comfortable and modest fits, avoiding overly tight or loose garments.

Bottoms

Skirts, dresses, shorts, and pants must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms are extended at the sides. No bottoms with rips or tears. Sweatpants and Joggers are allowed. Maintain a professional and appropriate appearance. Opt for comfortable and modest fits, avoiding overly tight or loose garments.

Footwear

Shoes must have non-removable backs for safety reasons, minimizing the risk of accidents. Slides, slippers, and flip-flops are prohibited. Students must wear appropriate footwear that provides comfort and facilitates mobility throughout the school day. Crocs with non-removable backs are permitted but cannot be worn during P.E. Activities.

Prohibited Attire:

Blankets, Loungewear, Spaghetti Strap Shirts, Crop Tops, Spandex, and/or pajamas are strictly prohibited as part of the school attire. Additionally, any clothing or accessories that display or suggest sexual, vulgar, drug, gang, weapons, or alcohol-related wording or graphics are strictly prohibited. Students must avoid wearing clothing that may incite violence or disrupt the school environment.
